Wirtland, ca. 1850

Built for Dr. William Wirt, Jr., in 1850, Wirtland is considered to be one of Virginia's outstanding examples of Gothic Revival domestic architecture, while its romantically landscaped park is a rare survival of Victorian landscaping.

Dr. Wirt was the son of William Wirt, a noted jurist, statesman, and biographer of Patrick Henry. Dr. Wirt was living in Baltimore in 1845 when he married Elizabeth Payne, the daughter of Daniel Payne of Bleak Hall in Westmoreland County, Virginia.
